Thinking it Over: Mentoring and Continuing Professional Development with Charles Neal and Dominic Davies

We are two very experienced therapists who have been working with sexual minority clients for over 25 years. We were the co-editors of the Pink Therapy series of books (Open University Press, 1996 & 2000) and are actively involved in the organisation Pink Therapy - which is the UK's largest independent therapy and training organisation specialising in working with gender and sexual minorities. We've both been supervising and training other therapists for a very long time and now wish to share some of this experience in a new venture....

We are offering the opportunity engage with us and a small group of other therapists for a day four times a year. Charles will run his group in Hastings, East

Sussex and Dominic will work from Soho, Central London.

You get to choose which of us you might work with and we ask you to commit to that group for the four meetings. Each meeting will focus on the training and development needs of the group members but will also be influenced by our respective current interests in the emerging field of gender and sexual minority therapy.

We imagine this will mean Charles and Dominic may suggest some reading before the workshop so we can have an informed discussion on a contemporary issue; we also imagine you might want to use the space for case discussion or to work through challenging ethical issues or to reflect on your practice in other ways

The fees for this year's programme will be £400 (payable in advance - installments may be possible). Lunch is included, and the group size will be limited to a maximum of six people per group (plus the facilitator).

We will also be available by appointment for telephone/ email or face-to-face coaching on request (for which a separate fee will be payable).
